## Arriving from air



Flying to Belgrade you will land at <u>Nikola Tesla Airport</u>. From the airport, you can reach the city in multiple ways.

### Reaching the city from the airport by bus

This is the cheapest way to reach the city. There are three bus lines:

A1 mini bus (Route: Airport – Slavija Square (Kralja Milutina Street) – Airport)

Approximate travel time - 30 minutes; price: 400 dinars (paid to the driver); from 6:30 until 19:00 on every 25 minutes. From Slavija Square you can reach the conference venue by bus line 31 and trolley lines 19, 21, 22, 29 (10-15 minutes ride).

**Public transportation line 72** (Route: Airport-Zeleni Venac Square)

Approximate travel time - 30–40 minutes (and longer); price: 50 dinars (paid via the app – <u>more info here</u>); from 05:25 - 04:50 on each 31-35 minutes. From Zeleni Venac Square you can walk to the conference venue (10 minutes uphill).

### Public Transportation Line 600 (Route: Train station "Beograd centar" – Airport)

Approximate travel time – 30-40 minutes; from 05:10 - 04:30 on each 30-35 minutes. Not very convenient if attempting to reach the conference venue.

### Reaching the city from the airport by taxi

To take a taxi, you must first obtain **a voucher at the designated desk** at the arrivals (you will see it after leaving the customs, near the exit from the airport building). The clerk will ask you for the address of your destination point, and provide you with the voucher of appropriate value. With this voucher, you should approach the first available taxi driver standing by the cars in front of the exit (taxi vehicles will be in line, visible from the exit point). Upon reaching your address, you will give the money to the taxi driver (cash, but sometimes also card – you should check this with the driver), and the voucher will guarantee the price, i.e., the amount of money. The price will depend on the exact location, but reaching the city centre from the airport should cost around 2000 - 3000 dinars (20~30 euros).

WARNING: Please be aware that there might be individuals standing in front of the exit and offering a ride. Please ignore them and continue to the line of taxi vehicles in front of the exit.

#### Reaching the airport from the city by taxi

Pink taxi (Google play app; App Store; Viber: +381604889979)

Paying method - kesh; credit cards (visa, maestro, master card, dina)

(approximately price: 1. Tariph working days 06:00 - 22:00 - 2.450 dinars (cc 22 euros); 2. Tariph working days 22:00 - 06:00 + Sunday - 3.000 dinars (cc 27-30 euros); a ride from the airport can be scheduled in advance by app or by Viber

### Naxis Taxi (Google Play App; App Store)

The price is similar to that of previous taxi service. A ride from the airport can be scheduled in advance by app or via the website

### <u>Car Go</u>

CarGo is a local Uber-like service. The app is available both for iOS and Android. Everything works the same as all similar services, such as Uber or Bolt, and the app is mostly the same. You must switch to English first by opening the settings menu at the top right corner (denoted by three horizontal lines). Find the option "Jezik" and choose English from the menu there. You also need to create an account and input payment details into the app to use it.

# Arriving by train

You can take off at one of the two train stations in the inner city area:

## 1. Novi Beograd

You can take tram lines 7 or 9 from Novi Beograd to reach the Old City—Savski trg (Stari grad), bus line 95 to reach the Old City (Zeleni Venac, Republic Square), bus line 83 to reach the Slavija Square, or call a taxi.

## 2. Prokop – the main (central) train station

From Prokop, you can get on the trolleybus line 41 to reach the Old City - Student square (from 05:00 - 04:45 on each 4-9 minutes), or bus line 44, both stops being a 6 minutes walk away from the station.

## Arriving by coach

The <u>coach station</u> is located in the Old City, near the Savski trg. You can reach the conference venue by 15 minutes walk uphill, or by public transportation (tram lines 7 and 9 to reach the Slavija Square, or bus lines 52, 53, 56 to reach Zeleni Venac).

## Arriving by car

Two major European highways are entering Belgrade: E70 from the West and E75 from the North and the South (connecting to A1). Some more information can be found on designated websites.

Near the Faculty of Philosophy (cc 5 minutes walking), there is the Public <u>Garage "Obilićev Venac"</u> (each commenced hour costs 120 dinars/approximately 1 euro per hour) and the Public Garage "Zeleni Venac" (cc 11 minutes walking; each commenced hour costs 100 dinars/approximately 0.85 euro per hour)
